BSI consolidates NBSP's testing, training, research, and custom functions into a dedicated operating location and facility. BSI services are available to government agencies at the federal, state, and local level and private sector agencies responsible for maintaining key components of the national infrastructure. This Introduction to Biometrics Course was developed by NBSP after conducting extensive analysis of the biometric community's training requirements. NBSP and its subsidiaries are ISO 9001:2000 certified and its laboratories are ISO/IEC 17025:2005 accredited.

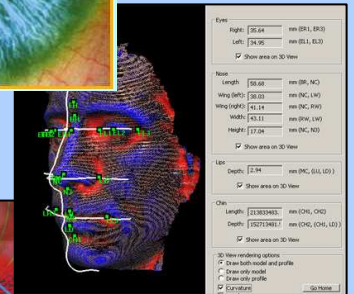
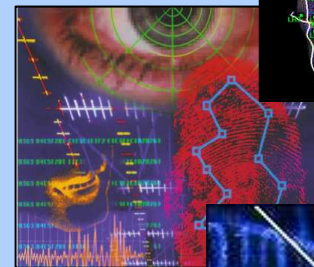
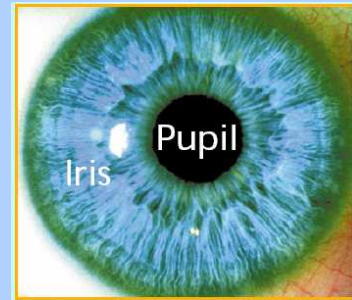

Introduction to Biometrics



One of the National Biometric Security Project's primary initiatives is the development and presentation of biometrics training programs. Our **Introduction to Biometrics Course** summarizes key aspects of all things biometric from ancient applications of biometric identifiers through the evolution and use of today's modern technologies. The program is ideally suited for managers and technicians, as well as senior executives and administrative support staff. This orientation can be tailored to meet the customer's content requirements.

Course Objectives:

- To demonstrate increased awareness of biometric technologies and their applications
- To identify considerations related to biometric modalities, applications, standards, and end-users

Course Outcomes:

- Participants will leave the course with the ability to utilize biometric terminology and definition correctly in situations where biometric application is proposed.
- Participants will leave the course with the ability to recognize a breadth of biometric applications.
- Participants will leave the course able to assess and identify biometric application considerations.
- Participants will leave the course able to develop questions that may affect the use of biometric systems
